OVERBITE MANAGEMENT USING LINGUAL ORTHODONTICS

Overbite is often felt as a contraindication by orthodontists for a lingual treatment.

However, the lingual technique is actually the best choice to treat these malocclusions. The contact between lower incisors and upper brackets is not a disadvantage. On the contrary, it promotes the movement of intrusion.

The goal of this lecture is to describe:

- The different steps of overbite correction
- The importance of torque control
- The repercussion in treatment of severe Class II

We will see that some complex cases become much simpler to treat after overbite correction.
